TUITION & FEES

2017-2018 School Year

School Application Fee: \$150.00 (Non-refundable)

A one-time **\$150 Application Fee** for all new families to be considered for enrollment if received by June 1st. Late registration is \$200 per family for applications received after June 1st .

Student Fees: \$125.00 per student for K- 12th grades (Non-refundable & Due after acceptance of admission)

Student Fees cover the costs for most field trips, SAT testing, drama scripts, lab supplies, student insurance and memberships, Student ID card, craft supplies and photocopies. Student fees are paid each year.

Book Fees: \$175.00 per student K- 12th grades (Non-refundable after books have been ordered for your student(s))

A book fee of \$175 per student will be charged and is due at the time of acceptance or re-enrollment.

Tuition: Tuition may be paid on a ten-month schedule (Sept-June) or a twelve-month schedule (July-June) and is due on the 1st of each month. The 12-month plan begins on July 1, 2017. Tuition also may be paid in full in September.

Fundraising: As is the nature of any privately funded educational institution, all of the funds necessary to provide students with the highest quality program available cannot come from tuition alone. Therefore, parents are asked to participate in fundraising activities. Each family will be responsible to raise the amount listed below through our fundraising program or may opt out of fundraising and make the tax deductible payment at their own expense in three installments.

Graduation Fee: There will be a fee of \$50 per graduating senior payable in March. This fee pays for the graduate's cap, gown and tassel.

School uniforms: Costs vary and are the responsibility of the parents.

Yearbooks: Purchased by the family.

Late Fees - \$25

Late fees will be charged when tuition, student fees, and fundraising quarterly payments are overdue. There is a 5- day grace period before late fees are applied.

Re-Enrollment Late Fees: HOS students will be automatically re-enrolled each school year unless a Student Withdrawal Form is submitted by April 15th. In the event that your family would withdraw after the April 15th opt-out deadline for re-enrollment, there will be a \$200 per student/\$500 maximum per family **Student Withdrawal Fee**. Families that opt-out prior to April 15th, then choose to re-enroll at a later date, will pay a \$200 per student/\$500 maximum per family **Late Re-Enrollment Registration Fee**. These fees help to recover the cost of separate curriculum orders, student costs, and teaching staff salaries.

Tuition Assistance Program: Financial Aid may be available. Eligibility is based on income and is assessed by an outside agency (FAST) on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please see the Administrative Assistant in the office for an application and more information.
